RESOLUTION NO. WD 2019-05 AUTHORIZATION TO HIRE BARTLE WELLS ASSOCIATES, BERKELEY, CA TO PREPARE A RATE STUDY REPORT IN COMPLIANCE WITH CALIFORNIA PROPOSITION 218

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE LELAND MEADOW WATER DISTRICT TO HIRE BARTLE WELLS ASSOCIATES TO PREPARE A RATE STUDY.

WHEREAS, Leland Meadow Water District ("District") provides potable water and wastewater services throughout the District.

WHEREAS, in August 2018, Leland Meadow Water District ("District") conducted a reserve study, performed by Associate Reserves. The study recommends that the District increase reserve funds to prepare for the repair and replacement of major District systems.

WHEREAS, the District believes, in light of the August 2018 reserve study, current user fees for potable water and wastewater services are insufficient to cover the costs of providing those services. The District must also insure adequate revenue to meet future financial obligations.

WHEREAS, the District must comply with the substantive and procedural requirements of Proposition 218 when increasing water and wastewater user fees, which require the District to prepare a rate study prepared by an independent licensed engineer.

WHEREAS, the District sought out independent engineers qualified to perform such rate studies at a cost relative to the size of the District.

WHEREAS, Bartle Wells Associates is a qualified independent engineer with experience preparing such Rate Study Reports and has provided a proposal at a reasonable price.

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the District Board of Directors hereby authorize the District to hire Bartle Wells Associates to perform a Rate Study Report as described in Bartle Wells Associates' proposal dated December 8, 2018.
